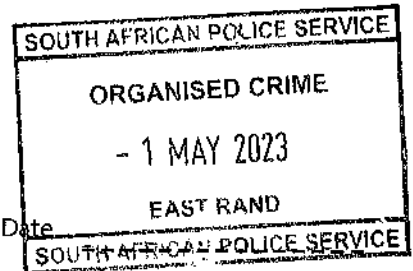

LOCALITY

This is an application for the granting of a Tavern Liquor Licence (On-Consumption), alternatively such licence that the Board, in its discretion, will deem appropriate in terms of Section 23 of the Gauteng Liquor Act, 2003 (Act No. 2 of 2003), in respect of **FG Corner** situated on Ground Floor, First Floor and Roof Top, Erf No. 456, No. 20 Main Rd, Melville in the magisterial district of Johannesburg.

TOBACCO PRODUCTS CONTROL AMENDMENT ACT, 1999 (ACT NO. 12 OF 1999)

The premises will be adequately furnished and equipped to comply with the Tobacco Products Control Amendment Act, 1999 (Act No. 12 of 1999) and that the necessary notices have been placed on strategic points within the premises to indicate the smoking area. The smoking area will be within the dining area, and will be fitted with loose tables and chairs. The smoking area will be closed off with a solid partitioning as prescribed in terms of the Tobacco Products Control Amendment Act, 1999. The "SMOKING AREA" sign will be displayed in the smoking area. The smoking area will be less than 25% of the total floor area as indicated on the plans.

INTRODUCTION

The proposed premises will have a sedative atmosphere where the clients can relax and have a meal with liquor complementary to the food. The primary business will be the supply of liquor and food will be secondary which means that it will be available to consume if requested by patrons.

A Tavern in terms of the Gauteng Liquor Act, 2003, (Act No. 2 of 2003) means: -

A place, whose main business is **THE SUPPLY OF LIQUOR, FOOD, AND VARIOUS FORMS OF ENTERTAINMENT**.

- (i). The applicant will operate a *boni fide* "Upmarket Entertainment Venue" type of business with various form of entertainment in the form of dancing, live music and televisions to watch music DVD's and sport event, etc.
- (ii). although the proposed premises has a fully equipped kitchen, the proposed premises will operate on a convenience food (buy-in)-system. A convenience food system or buy in system according to the Oxford Dictionary means and I quote: - "those that are convenient to use because he need little preparation". Meals will be served at the premises.

The applicant / member appreciate the current tendency, that licensed premises should not simply be places to consume food but also to be there for the convenience of the public to have a social drink with light refreshments and a snack meal.

The latest Liquor Act, 2003 has heralded a new approach to the granting of an on-consumption liquor licence and it is submitted that it will be with this intent of Act No. 2 of 2003 to grant the liquor licence applied for, herein and thereby providing a facility which do not presently exist within the considerable area revered to.

The applicant / member are of the opinion that he has proofed in this representation that the proposed premises will be well situated without fear of undesirable elements and that be complies with in terms of Section 30 (2) (d) of the Gauteng Liquor Act, 2003, (Act No. 2 of 2003)

There will be ample parking available at the proposed premises where patrons can have secure parking and where delivery trucks can park without obstructing the traffic flow.

The following Court Ruling must be brought under the attention of the Chairman of the Liquor Board: -

In a decision in Exparte President of the Conference of the Methodist Church 1993 (2) SA 679 the court reconsidered a previous point of view for Public Interest and on cit. 10E-G of the report came to the conclusion that the position in law that: -

"..... The phrase the public interest does not permit of a clear comprehensive definition. As was observed by Herstein J in Argus Printing & Publishing Co Limited v Darby Artware (Pty) Ltd and Others, 1952 (2) SA 1 (C) one must adopt, in giving effect to the phrase, a broad common-sense view of the position as a whole (and it must be considered whether), that the public would be better served if the application were to be allowed to proceed with its scheme than by a continuation of the existing state of affairs."

In this case the following factors were also discussed namely: -

"..... if there is a need, and if so, if it will be convenient for the public and if the safety and welfare of the community as a whole will be effected in any way, and that it will not degrade the health and hygiene and or have a negative effect on the morals and order in the area and that it will not disturb the "peace and quiet " of the residence in the area".

If all the positive and negative aspects are looked at, the Competent Authority will find that a Tavern Liquor Licence is suitable for the premises and it is will serve the community of Johannesburg that visit the proposed premises and therefore it will be in the **public interest** if the premises are licensed.

The applicant / member do not foresee any security or welfare problems in the area because he will have strict control on the premises.

With the subject application, the applicant / member are being placed in the position whether he can proceed to apply his business acumen and the skills to the benefit of the general public of the inhabitants of the area surrounding the proposed premises.

The Government identified a protagonist of private enterprise and especially small business development as same is labour intensive and assists in alleviating unemployment, particularly amongst the disadvantaged citizens.

The Bill of Rights Section of the Constitution entrenches the right to freely participating in the economy, provided that such rights is exercised with due regard to measures designed to promote the protection of life,

economic growth, human development, fair labour practice or equal opportunities for all, providing further that such measures are justifiable in an open democratic society based on freedom, human dignity and equality.

Promoting of private enterprise results in better economic competition to the benefit of the general public.

The applicant / member respectfully submit that in the subject application, there is no reason or grounds why his rights as previously mentioned should be curtailed or limited.

Every business venture will contribute to help build the economy of South Africa and that will be done if the application is approved, because the applicant / member will employ eight permanent workers. This will be in line "GEAR" an initiative of Governments for job creation.

The applicant / member are not disqualified in terms of Section 37 of the Gauteng Liquor Act, 2003 (Act No. 2 of 2003) or the Liquor Act, 1989 (Act No. 27 of 1989), to hold a liquor licence because applicant / member have never been arrested, charged, convicted or been declared insolvent ext. according to Section 37.

The applicant / member are experienced businesspersons, show good character, has a friendly appearance, and has a good relationship with others, therefore it will be an asset to the public, and he will operate an honest and profitable business.

Although there are immediate competition it will give the applicant / member the opportunity to compete with other similar businesses on equal ground in the Johannesburg area.

Competition is good for existing business in the area and that is the norm on which the Gauteng Liquor Act is based.

COMPETITION CAN BRING ACCEPTABLE RESULTS ONLY WHEN IT'S ACCOMPANIED BY EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES.

The applicant / member accept that he will be in competition with existing businesses and this is accepted, particularly since the competition will be in the interest of the general public.

THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY CAN BE ASSURED THAT NO POSSIBILITY EXISTS THAT THE GRANTING OF THIS APPLICATION MAY CAUSE A HARMFUL MONOPOLISTIC CONDITION TO ARISE OR BE AGGRAVATED IF THIS APPLICATION IS APPROVED.

The application for a Tavern Liquor Licence will be in the public interest to serve the needs of the public who wants to visit the proposed premises.

If the applicant / member did not identified such a demand this application would not have been lodged, and the applicant would not have spent so much money to start the business.

The applicant / member supply the demand there is for a *boni fide* "Upmarket Entertainment Venue" with entertainment" within the Melville area.

Accordingly it is prayed that the licence should be granted.

It is the applicant's submission that the Chairperson of the Board can approve the application for the Tavern Liquor Licence, alternatively such licence that the Board, in its discretion, will deem appropriate because she / he can be convinced that –

The procedures prescribed in the Gauteng Liquor Act and Regulations were strictly followed and adhered to and the application compiled and lodged consisted of the following documents and information, complete and comprehensive as prescribed in terms of section 23 of the Gauteng Liquor Act and Regulations and following the sequence of section 23:-

1. Section 23(1) – The prescribed form, Form 1 was duly commissioned marked Annexure "B".

2. Section 23(1)(a) – A detailed written motivation in support of the application, addressing the criteria laid down in section 30(2) and (3) of the Liquor Act, marked Annexure “E”.
3. Section 23(1)(b) – A detailed plan of the proposed premises was lodged, to be shop fitted and furnished in accordance with the quality standards, marked Annexure “T”.
4. Section 23(1)(c)c) – A detailed written description of the proposed premises, together with coloured photographs depicting the building in which the proposed Tavern were to be erected, were attached, marked Annexure “D”.
5. Section 23(1) (e) – Proof of notice in the newspapers as determined in terms of section 23 of the Act. 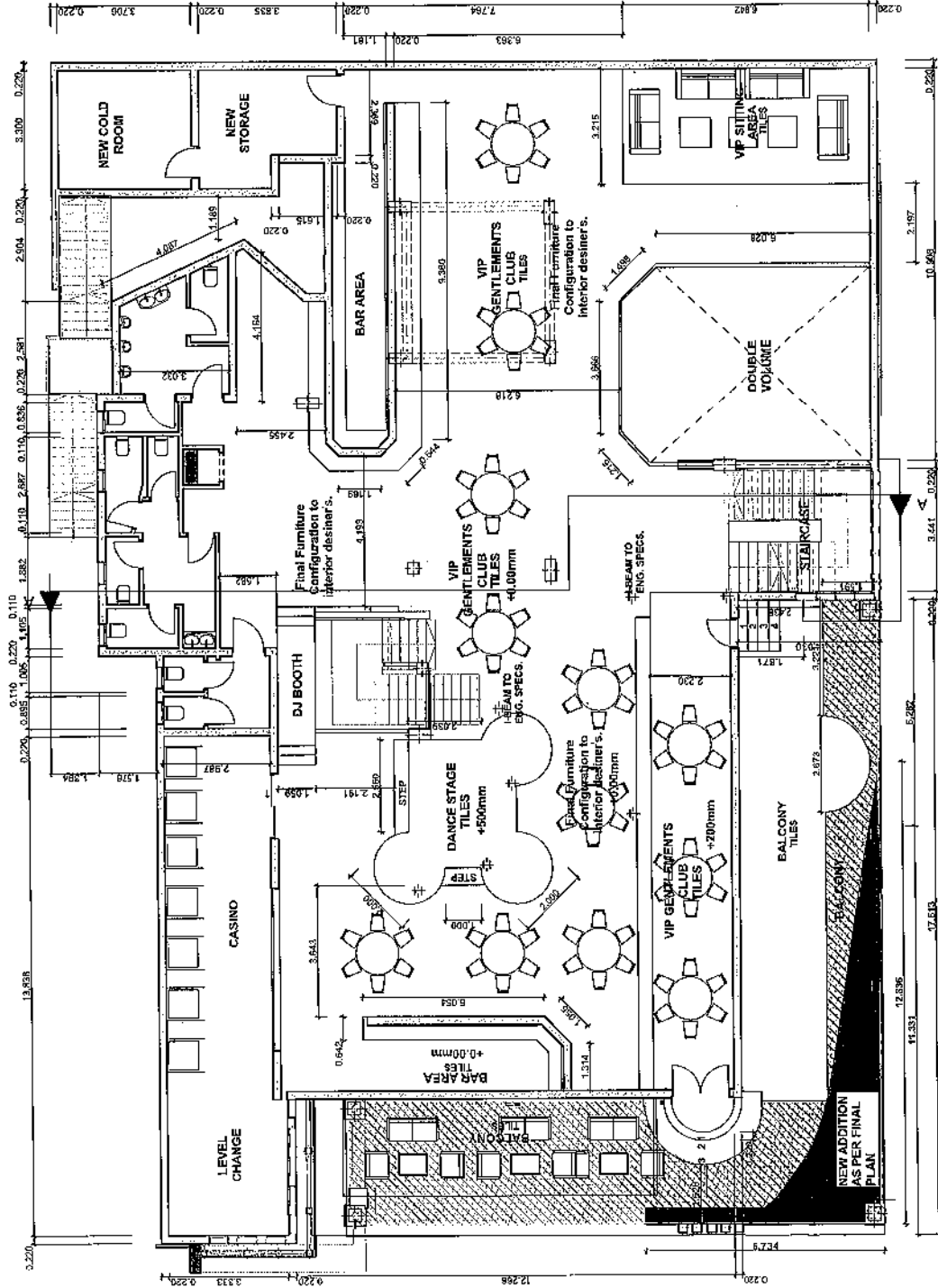

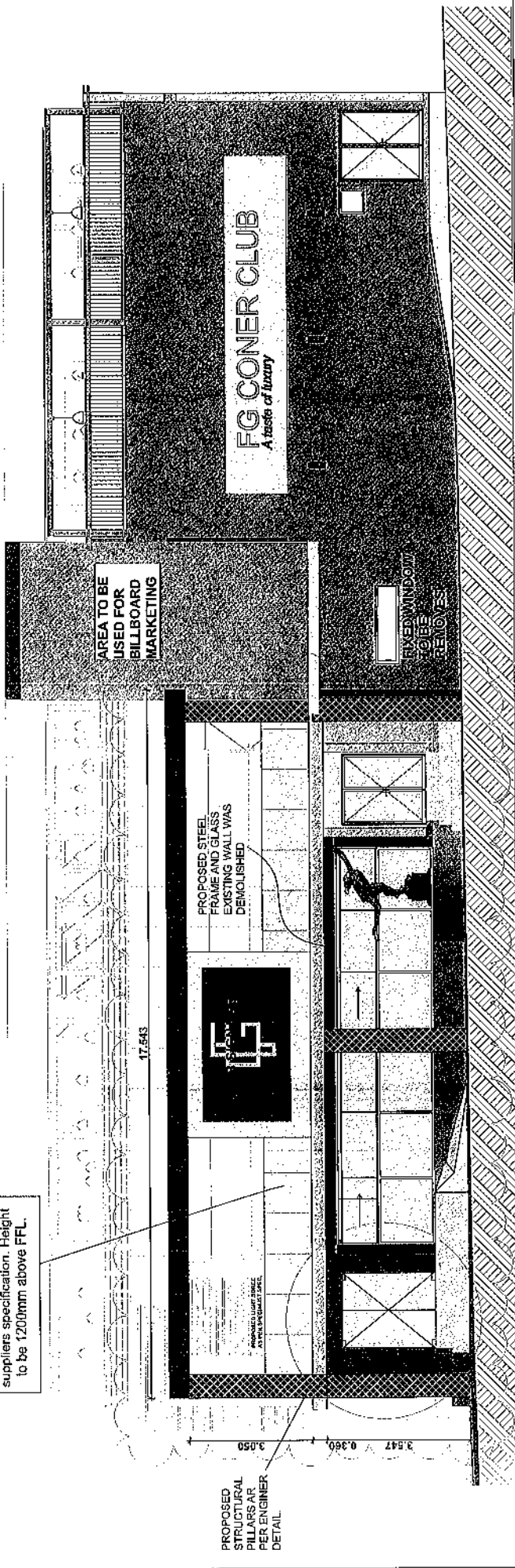
