In a decision in <u>Exparte President of the Conference of the Methodist Church 1993 (2) SA 679</u> the court reconsidered a previous point of view for Public Interest and on cit. 10E-G of the report came to the conclusion that the position in law that: -

In this case the following factors were also discussed namely: -

"...... if there is a need, and if so, if it will be convenient for the public and if the safety and welfare of the community as a whole will be effected in any way, and that it will not degrade the health and hygiene and or have a negative effect on the morals and order in the area and that it will not disturb the "peace and quiet" of the residence in the area".

If all the positive and negative aspects are looked at, the Competent Authority will find that a Tavern Liquor Licence is suitable for the premises and it is will serve the community of Johannesburg that visit the proposed premises and therefore it will be in the **public interest** if the premises are licensed.
